Third Anniversary of Vitasoy Community Care Programme Continues to Promote Healthy Diets in Rural Schools, Nurtures Children's Growth through Nutrition and Exercise

Over the past three years, the Programme has reached 11 rural districts and counties across 7 provinces, including Guangdong, Hebei, Henan, Gansu, Shanxi, Hunan, and Guizhou, distributing over 4.5 million packs of nutritious Vitasoy Soyabean Milk and benefitting around 7,000 rural children in 49 schools.

In addition to providing nutritious Vitasoy Soyabean Milk, Vitasoy offered health education classes and sports activities as part of the Programme. These initiatives encouraged children and adolescents to cultivate healthy habits, including adopting balanced diets and exercising regularly, supporting them to become students who "Eat Well, Exercise Well, and Sleep Well". During the Programme, Vitasoy volunteers guided students in constructing paper planes from Vitasoy recycled beverage cartons while delivering engaging lessons on plant-based nutrition and environmental protection.

The Programme has extended beyond the classroom by providing sports sessions. Joined by national athletes, teachers, and volunteers from Vitasoy, these interactive sessions encouraged children to develop exercise habits, boosted their willpower, and promoted their physical and mental development, laying a solid foundation for a healthy future.
